Well Name: Jeter Branch (Caddo County, Louisiana, US)

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Rig Arrives, Testing to Begin at Jeter Branch

Austin Exploration Limited ("Austin") (ASX code: AKK) today advised that a drill rig has arrived at its Jeter Branch prospect and that testing of the previously identified potential pay is expected to begin shortly.

Austin also announced that it has taken over operatorship and that it now holds a 50% working interest in the Jeter Branch prospect.

David Schuette, Austin Managing Director, said: "We had hoped to have this rig on-site in September, but due to several obstacles with the rig, the heavy rains and a few regulatory logistics, we were delayed.

"We now have the rig on-site and should begin perforation and testing of the previously announced pay zones in the coming days. We will be perforating the Petit formation which is primarily a limestone in this area. The sidewall core analysis completed in August recovered oil at the 5,500 ft zone and indicated an 11-14% porosity." Mr Schuette said.

About Jeter Branch

The Jeter Branch prospect, a wildcat prospect in Caddo Parish, Louisiana, US, is surrounded by producing wells with the closest producing facility less than two miles away.

Within the prospect is the test well, the Flex Energy Lewis La. Properties #1, which has an elevated and dry drill site with gas pipelines, located approximately 7000 feet from the well.

On September 5, 2007, drilling reached a total depth of 6300 ft.

Aus-Tex, Austin's wholly owned subsidiary, originally had a carried working interest of 15% and a revenue interest of 11.1% in this well until the Austin elected to take over operatorship and increase its working interest to 50%.
